1. Release the permits without conditions.

Following the AASHTO guideline: for the ELST trail system width consist of 18 ' foot print which consist of 12 ' paved, 2' gravel shoulder and 1 ' clear zone on both sides.

As a citizen, the completion of the trail ELST is important to be completed in a timely manner. Please request to have these permits released immediate without any conditions so the ELST trail system can be completed and enjoyed by its community.
