

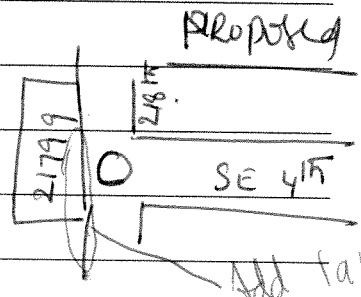
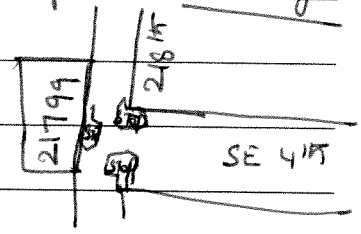

The proposed roundabout could lead to high risk of traffic accidents from

- 1) vehicle vs. vehicle: passing vehicles which might not slow down considerably
- 2) vehicle vs. pedestrian; ~~passing~~ vehicles which might ignore pedestrians from Rees's Run
- 3) vehicle vs. residence: A drunk/negligent driver coming from SE 4th runs into the residence damaging the property and/or resulting in fatalities
