**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SAMMAMISH,
WASHINGTON, ACCEPTING FEDERAL ECONOMIC
STIMULUS FUNDS FOR THE EAST LAKE SAMMAMISH
PARKWAY NE PHASE 1B PROJECT – NE 18TH PLACE TO NE
26TH STREET**

WHEREAS, the Federal government enacted the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) of 2009 to provide a stimulus to the U.S. economy to counteract the effects of the current economic downturn, including providing substantial funding for infrastructure improvements; and projects receiving ARRA funds were selected through an extremely competitive process managed by the Puget Sound Regional Council; and

WHEREAS, ARRA funds administered by the Puget Sound Regional Council are available only for transportation projects; and

WHEREAS, project selection was based primarily on project readiness, i.e. “shovel ready” projects; and

WHEREAS, the City was successful in receiving American Recovery and Reinvestment Act funds totaling \$3.5 million for the East Lake Sammamish Parkway NE Phase 1B Project, scoring 98 out of a total 100 points possible for funding eligibility and;

WHEREAS, the ARRA funds awarded to the City for East Lake Sammamish Parkway NE Phase 1B project cannot be used for any other use;

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAMMAMISH,
WASHINGTON, DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Accepting ARRA Funding. The City Manager is hereby authorized take all steps necessary to accept and obligate American Recovery and Reinvestment Act funding for the East Lake Sammamish Parkway NE Phase 1B project in the amount of Three Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$3,500,000.00).

Section 2. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon signing by the Mayor.
