Project Description:	<p>This road-improvement project seeks to reduce traffic congestion and to increase traffic, pedestrian, and bicycle safety.</p> <p>Project improvements to the East Lake Sammamish Parkway include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 12-foot-wide, center left-turn lane where driveways or roadway intersections are located along the length of the project; • Landscaped center median at locations without a turn lane; • One 11-foot-wide general-purpose travel lane in each direction; • One 5-foot-wide bike lane in each direction; • Curbs and gutters on both sides of the roadway; • A 5-foot-wide planter strip and 6-foot-wide sidewalk on the east side of the roadway (planter strips may be eliminated in some areas because of steep driveways); • Street lighting at intersections; • 10 to 15 foot high retaining walls on the west side along most of the length of the project; and average 5-foot retaining walls on the east side through portions of the project length; and • Storm drainage collection and treatment systems.
